JANUARY 5, 2009

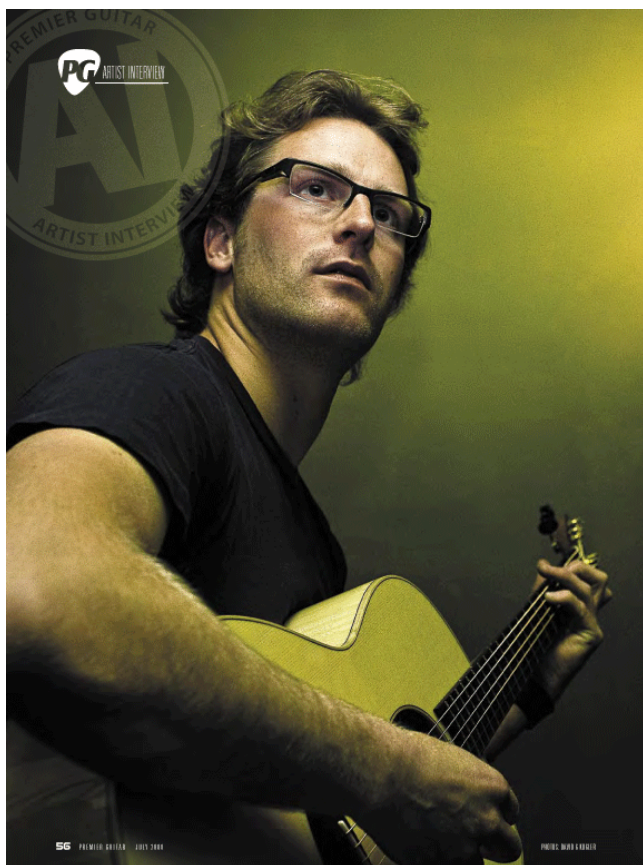
MARCUSEATONTRIO will be touring with Tim Reynolds & his rock trio, TR3 starting the end of this month.
